



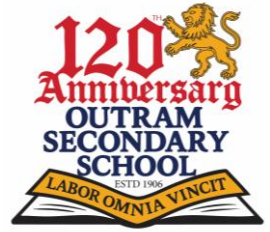

- **resilience** - Outramians to build coping mechanisms, strengths, grit and determination through the "I am, I can, and I have" framework;

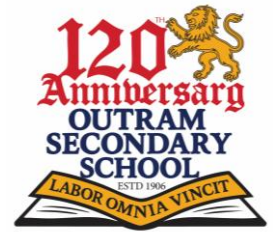

Applied Learning Elective Module (ApLM@Poly and ApLM@ITE)

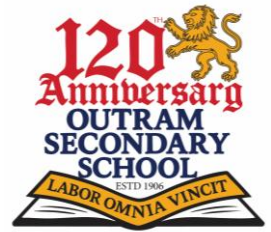

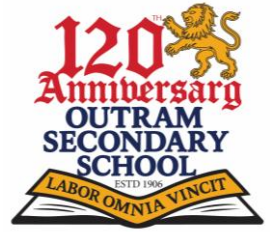

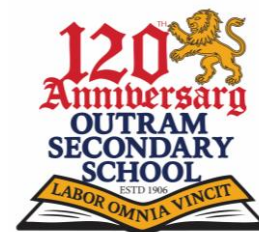
