Letter to Parents - Term 2 2024

Greetings from Outram Secondary School!

We hope that everyone has had a restful break with your family and loved ones during the March holiday break. On behalf of all staff in Outram Secondary School, we warmly welcome Outramians back to school for another enriching period of learning in Term 2.

Information for All Levels:

1. Student Development Theme for Term 2 - Leaders of Integrity

In line with our school vision, we would like to focus on the student development theme for **Term 2 – Leaders of Integrity**. Integrity is about choosing to do what is right even when no one is observing. It is an integral value that we strive to develop in each Outramian to becoming a contributing and concerned citizen.

This theme essentially guides the growth and grooming of our Outramians to be capable leaders who:

- demonstrate strong moral principles- Outramians will be nurtured well to develop a strong sense of right and wrong, and to act in accordance with these principles;
- take ownership and responsibility- Outramians will be encouraged to take ownership of their actions, decisions, and consequences, and to be accountable for their mistakes;









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- lead with honesty and transparency- Outramians will be taught to communicate openly and honestly, and to lead by example in promoting credibility and a culture of trust; the values of passion and inventiveness are emphasised with this end in mind;
- embody resilience and perseverance- Outramians will be encouraged to develop the resilience and perseverance needed to overcome challenges and stay committed to their values and beliefs: and
- become positive role models- Outramians who inspire confidence will become positive role models for their peers, promoting a spirit to strive for excellence.

2. Safeguarding the Safety of All: Road Safety Reminders

To ensure the safety of our students, we appeal to parents/guardians who are driving their child/ward to school to abide by the vehicular arrangements of the school:

- There is strictly no parking for parents/guardians dropping off or picking up their child/ward before or after school.
- All vehicles are to enter the school through the back gate before 7.25 am.
- After 7.25 am, vehicles are not allowed into the school compound for safety reasons. Parents/guardians may drop their child/ward off at the public carpark opposite the front gate (Block 13, York Hill HDB open-air carpark) and students may then use the zebra crossing to enter the compound on foot.
- Parents/guardians may also wait at the same carpark to pick their child/ward up after school dismissal.
- Please do not stop along the road of York Hill for drop-off or pick-up where there are clear zig-zag markings alerting drivers that there is a pedestrian crossing up ahead. Vehicles are not allowed to overtake, wait, or park in the area of this road marking. Pedestrians are not allowed to cross the road at these zigzag areas as well.









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• Entry to school for pick-up or drop-off through the front gate is strictly prohibited except during wet weather.

 Please be reminded to strictly observe transport safety rules and procedures within the school compound. We would like to appeal to all parents/guardians to cooperate with our school staff and security officers to enhance traffic safety around and in our school.
