Safeguarding the Safety of All: Road Safety Reminders

To ensure the safety of our students, we appeal to parents/ guardians who are driving their child(ren)/ ward(s) to school to abide by the vehicular arrangements of the school:

- There is strictly no parking for parents/ guardians dropping off or picking up their children before
 or after school.
- All vehicles are to enter the school through the back gate before 7.25 am.
- After 7.25 am, vehicles are not allowed into the school compound for safety reasons. Parents/ guardians may drop their child(ren)/ ward(s) off at the public carpark opposite the front gate (Block 13, York Hill HDB open-air carpark) and students may then use the zebra crossing to enter the compound on foot.
- Parents/ guardians may also wait at the same carpark to pick their child(ren)/ ward(s) up after school dismissal.









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- Please do not stop along the road of York Hill for drop-off or pick-up where there are clear zig-zag markings alerting drivers that there is a pedestrian crossing up ahead. Vehicles are not allowed to overtake, wait, or park in the area of this road marking. Pedestrians are not allowed
- Entry to school for pick-up or drop-off through the front gate is strictly prohibited except during wet weather.

Please be reminded to strictly observe transport safety rules and procedures within the school compound. We would like to appeal to all parents/ guardians to co-operate with our school staff and security officers to enhance traffic safety around and in our school.

Vaping Updates

E-vaporisers are illegal in Singapore. Under the Tobacco (Control of Advertisements and Sale) Act, the possession, use or purchase of e-vaporisers carries a maximum fine of \$2,000. It is also an offence to import, distribute, sell or offer for sale e-vaporisers and their components. Any person convicted of such offences is liable to a fine of up to \$10,000, or imprisonment of up to six months or both for the first offence, and a fine of up to \$20,000, or imprisonment of up to 12 months or both for the second or subsequent offence. All prohibited tobacco items will be seized and confiscated.

MOE takes a firm stand against vaping. Vaping is categorised as a serious offence. When students are caught using or in possession of e-vaporisers, the prohibited product will be confiscated, and their parents will be informed. The schools will report the offender to HSA and manage vaping-related offences through existing disciplinary frameworks. These include taking school-based disciplinary actions, such as suspension or caning (for boys). Students caught vaping will also be placed on cessation support programmes where counsellors will guide them through their cessation journey to effect long-term behavioural change.

Parents have an important part to play in their children's education. There are resources and relevant information that parents can access on Parent Hub. Parents are encouraged to have a serious conversation with their children about vaping to prevent it from becoming a life-long habit. Project Wolbachia: Release of Male Wolbachia-Aedes Mosquitoes every Tuesday & Friday to Help Fight Dengue in the Neighbourhood

As part of Project *Wolbachia* – Singapore, the National Environment Agency (NEA) will be releasing male *Wolbachia-carrying Aedes aegypti* (*Wolbachia-Aedes*) mosquitoes to help fight dengue in the neighbourhood starting from 26 March 2024. Releases will be carried out at residential areas which may include the vicinity of schools every Tuesday & Friday mornings (6.30 am – 11.00 am). You and/or your child may notice more mosquitoes at the school's vicinity but need not be worried, as male mosquitoes do not bite unlike their female counterpart.
