Brief History

Year	Important Milestone
1906	Founded as Outram Road School, named after Sir James Outram, a British General who served the British Government from 1819 to 1860
Up to 1942	Functioned as a Primary School and was a feeder school to Raffles Institution
1954	Functioned as a 4-year Secondary Commercial School, offering the School Certificate of Commercial Education of the London Chamber of Commerce

1961	Renamed Outram Secondary School
1977	Swimming Pool Complex was completed and officially opened
2006	Celebrated Outram Centennial Celebrations and launched the Outram Centennial Commemorative Book
2007	Niche Programme School for Rock Climbing & First school in Singapore to offer GCE 'O' Level Business Studies

19 first-year recruits, 14 second-year recruits and just two non-commissioner officers, LCP Koh Kim San and LCP Abdul Rahman bin Abdullah. That year, the Police Cadet Corps Unit emerged champions in the Commissioner's Challenge Trophy Competition.

Leadership Changes

Principal C.A. Peterson left Outram at the end of 1956, and he was succeeded by Chua Leong Hin. Chua, a Science and Mathematics master from Raffles Institution had previously been Principal of Ama Keng School (1951-1952). In 1952, he established Bartley Secondary School and was the school's first principal till 1955. In March 1955, he established the Alexandra Estate Secondary School and remained there till January 1956 when he was appointed Principal of Gan Eng Seng School. Before Chua could take his position at Gan Eng Seng, he was requested to help establish Tanjong Katong Secondary Technical School as well as Queenstown Secondary Technical School.



Chan Sing Chun, who joined Outram School as a teacher in 1961, remembered Chua as his Mathematics teacher at Raffles Institution. Chua was, in Chan's words, an 'excellent teacher' who was a specialist in technical subjects. Chua was the right person to lead Outram through the changes during this period for he strongly felt that a commercial education was very beneficial for the students. Chua left Outram School in 1960 and was succeeded by O.K. Abraham (1960-1961). When Abraham was transferred to Siglap Secondary School on 1 January 1962, he was succeeded by M.A. Mallal, a former master from Raffles Institution. The latter served as Outram's Principal from 1962 to 1964 when he was transferred to Anderson Secondary School. In 1964, Chan Joon Gek, one of Outram's longest-serving principals took over the helm.

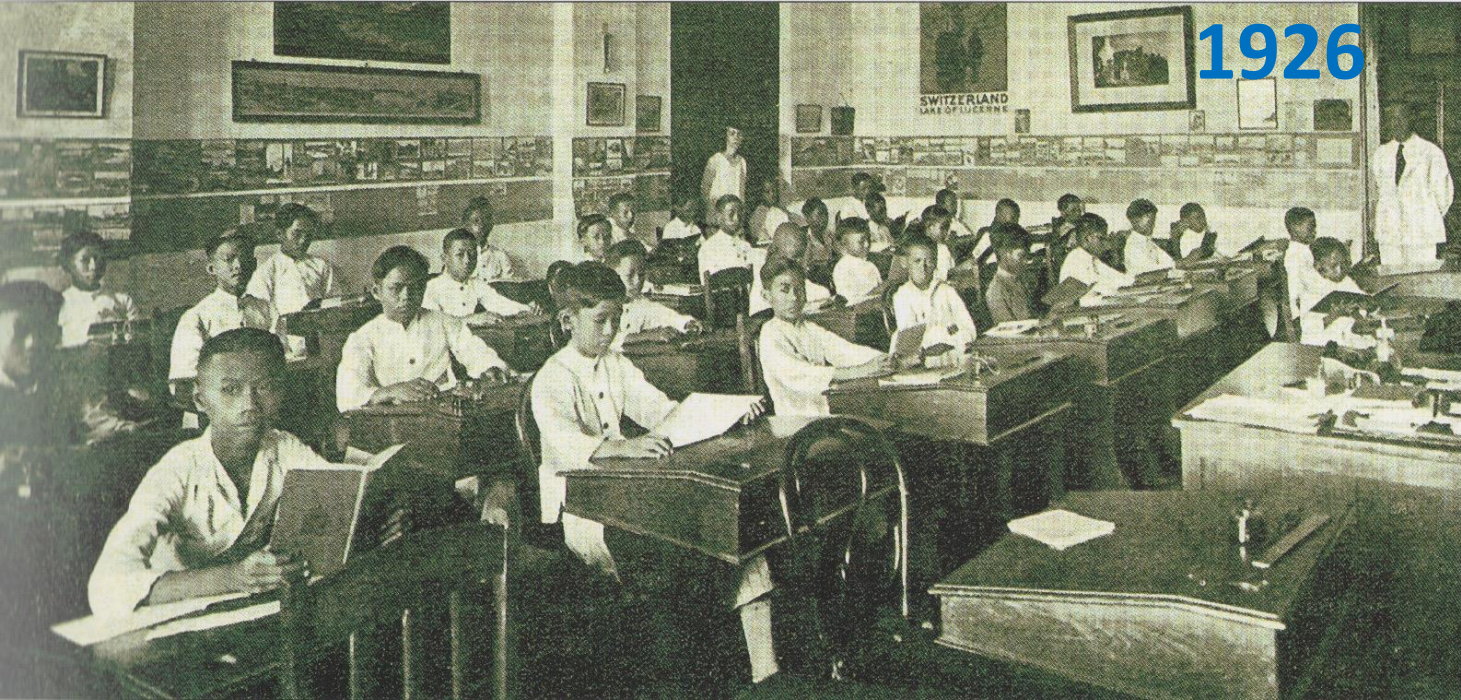

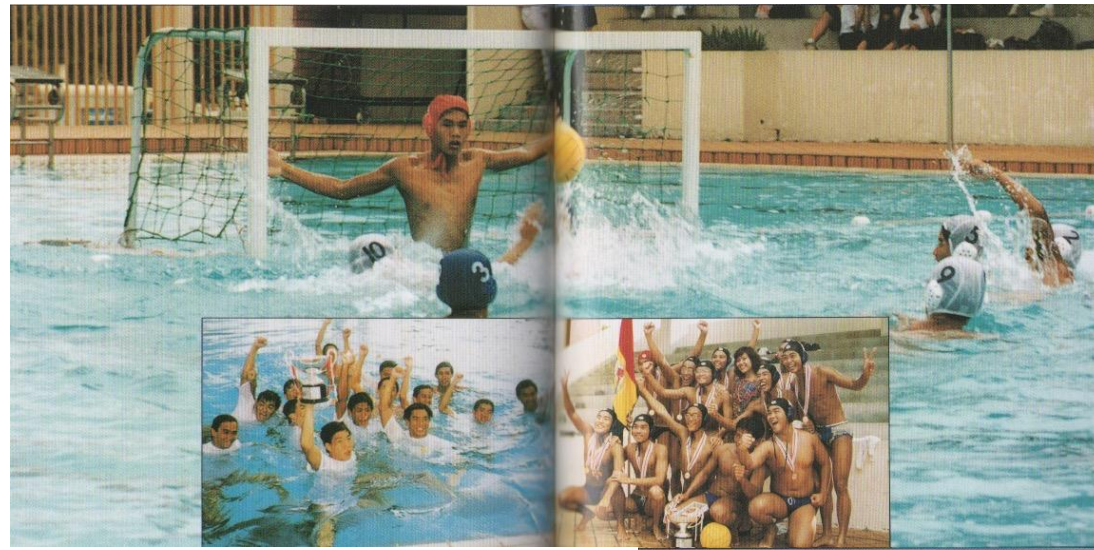

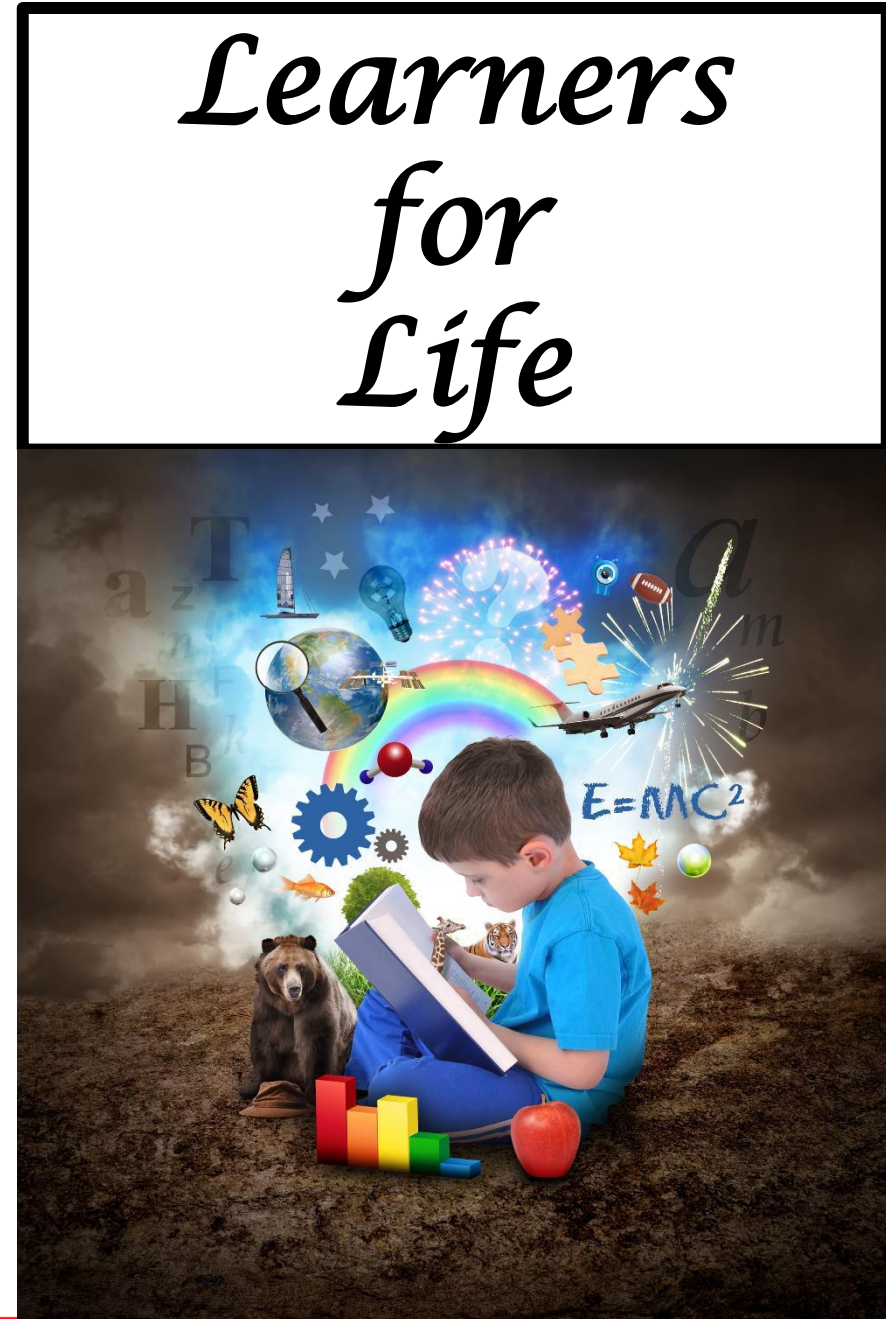
