School Policy

- CCA is **Compulsory** for every secondary sch's student
- Each student must participate in **ONE** CCA offered by the school
- **Participation** to be continuous throughout the 4 or 5 years before CCA points are awarded and converted to a **CCA grade**.
- Achieved **CCA Attendance \geq 75% each year** (CCA points will only be awarded if this is attained).
- CCA points computed based on **MOE LEAPS 2.0 CCA Grading scheme**





Key Domains in LEAPS 2.0

Participation

- Recognition of active contribution, exemplary conduct

Achievement

- Recognition of achievements beyond CCA, beyond school

Leadership

- Recognition beyond leadership position to include leadership quality with respect to self and others

Service

- Recognition beyond hours to include VIA - planning, service, reflection
